SUBJECT: Solaris 10 Rollout for 2008

The System Office is initiating the rollout of Solaris 10 to all colleges running the CIS Template in the North Carolina Community College System. This introductory Numbered Memo is intended to give you initial instructions and information for your participation in this rollout.

Points that each college need to know are:

- Each college System Administrator will be required to participate in an informational telecom per the table below. Attendance will be taken. We will use the System Office number (919.501.4274) for the initial calls. Please locate your college in the table below for the date and time of the call for your institution.
- All colleges must complete the Readiness Survey for upgrading to Solaris 10. The survey is attached to this Numbered Memo. Questions on the survey will be discussed during the information call. Please review the survey before the call and have your questions ready. We request that all surveys be returned to the System Office by June 30, 2008.
- Each college must provide a primary date and two (2) secondary dates for cutover to Solaris 10 at your institution. The dates should be driven by local college requirements for scheduling resources, planned outage, etc. This is necessary so the System Office can schedule support for the colleges during the actual upgrade. Once we have your dates, we will develop and publish an overall schedule that includes all colleges. We will make every effort to accommodate your primary and, if necessary, secondary dates. Please do not include holidays, however, we highly suggest weekend dates, such as Friday or Saturday, for your cutover. Each college must include a cutover date(s) in the survey when returning it to the System Office.
- If you have not already done so, you should plan to acquire the Solaris 10 software (05/08) at least 30 days prior to your scheduled upgrade.

- Regular informational telecoms/webinars will be planned for the rollout. After the initial informational call, the colleges will be grouped based upon dates submitted for their respective cutovers. This grouping may not match the groups used for the information and initial telecom.
- The Solaris 10 upgrade will include a pilot phase involving a small number of colleges. There will be separate and specific communications forthcoming regarding the pilot for those colleges involved.

The Solaris 10 system wide rollout is targeted for completion by the end of October, 2008. Tom Hill, of the System Office, will be your Solaris 10 Rollout Coordinator.
