The Basic Skills Office is pleased to invite <u>up to 40 individuals from across the state</u> to participate in the Leadership Excellence Academy, a two-year nationally-developed professional development opportunity that will allow you to explore, adapt, and apply actual leadership concepts and skills specific to your adult education and literacy program.

The Academies are designed to support local adult education leaders and those striving to become leaders. Both new and experienced managers will benefit from participation, so select staff members whom you feel would benefit from participation. As many local managers are nearing retirement age, the Academies can also assist with transitional planning. Up to forty applicants will be selected to participate.

- You will have opportunities to formulate and implement approaches to instructional leadership problems and issues and interact with other program managers who face similar challenges.
- You will have the opportunity to become one of the first program administrators in the country to earn *national certification in program improvement* as well as nine hours of *graduate credit* in Educational Administration if you so desire.
- Training will occur over time with opportunities for application through a series of interim activities and learning projects.
- Technology-based delivery such as online courses, discussion boards, and webcasts will be combined with face-to-face workshops by experienced national adult education trainers and will provide opportunities to interact with peers from other states.

The Leadership Excellence Academy is a joint initiative of the National Adult Education Professional Development Consortium (NAEPDC) and ProLiteracy America.

What is it?

The Leadership Excellence Academy is a two-year professional development opportunity that will allow you to explore, adapt, and apply actual leadership concepts and skills specific to your adult education and literacy program. You will have opportunities to formulate and implement approaches to instructional leadership problems and issues and interact with other program managers who face similar challenges.

- The Academies are built upon a foundation of research, theory, professional wisdom, and best practices.
- Training will occur over time with opportunities for application through a series of interim activities and learning projects.
- Technology-based delivery such as online courses, discussion boards, and webcasts will be combined with face-to-face workshops.
- You will have the opportunity to earn national certification in program improvement as well as nine hours of graduate credit in Educational Administration from Ohio University.
- You will receive training by experienced leaders in the adult education field.
- You will participate in a learning community with your peers from other states through regularlyscheduled webcasts.

Who should participate?

The Academies are designed to support local adult education leaders and those striving to become leaders. Both new and experienced managers will benefit from participation. As many local managers are nearing retirement age, the Academies can also assist with transitional planning. The Academies offer a great opportunity to begin training some lead teachers or other program coordinators who have interest in assuming a larger leadership role in the future.

What are my responsibilities as a participant?

Between October, 2008 - May, 2010, you will:

YEAR 1 - 2008 - 2009:

- Actively participate in:
 - Three six-hour face-to-face workshops,
 - Two one-hour online courses, and
 - Three one-hour webcasts.
- Complete and submit two interim activities between the face-to-face workshops.
 - All interim activities must be posted to the electronic portfolio by the designated deadline date to be eligible for national certification and/or graduate credit.
- Begin Part I of your culminating project.

YEAR 2 - 2009 - 2010:

- Activity participate in:
 - Two six-hour face-to-face workshops,
 - One six-hour online course, and
 - Three one-hour webcasts.
- Complete and submit two interim activities between the face-to-face workshops.
- Complete your culminating learning project (actual submission date will be April 2010.)

Is there a cost?

The state is covering the training costs. Your costs will be your travel-related expenses to and from the workshops. In addition, there is a \$75 application fee if you complete all of the required activities and qualify for national certification at the end of Year 2. If you desire to earn the nine hours of graduate credit, a significantly reduced tuition fee is being offered through Ohio University.
