World View is pleased to announce a workshop for community college educators to be held November 12-13, 2008, at the Friday Center, 140 Friday Center Drive, Chapel Hill, North Carolina. *This program is designed for faculty and administrators in all disciplines.*

Join us as we explore how we are connected to the world through the lens of global health. It's difficult to understand globalization in our interconnected world without a solid grounding in global health issues. This program's goals are to provide that background, inspire educators to integrate these issues in their daily instruction, and give them the resources to do so.

Leading scholars from Duke University, North Carolina State, and UNC - Chapel Hill will address the major issues of global health in an age of globalization. Small group sessions will focus on a range of global health topics. College-based teams will meet with a faculty advisor to develop a global initiative plan.

Registration fee is \$150 per person or \$500 for a team of 4 individuals from the same college (save \$100) and \$125 for each additional team member.
