RE: 2016-17 Tuition and Registration Fee Rates

This memo is provided to notify colleges of 2016-17 tuition and registration fee rates.

G.S. 115D-5 states that “[t]he State Board shall have authority with respect to individual institutions... to establish and regulate student tuition and fees within policies for tuition and fees established by the General Assembly.” To date, the General Assembly has NOT debated a tuition or registration fee increase during the current legislative session. While a final budget has not yet been enacted into law, both House and Senate versions of the budget (H1030) are **in agreement with NOT implementing** a tuition or registration fee increase for the 2016-17 academic year.

Given that the General Assembly has not proposed a tuition increase, curriculum tuition charged to students for the 2016-17 academic year shall remain at current levels:

Residents: The per credit hour charge shall remain **\$76.00**; up to a maximum per semester of **\$1,216**, based upon 16 credit hours of instruction.

Non-Residents: The per credit hour charge shall remain **\$268**; up to a maximum per semester of **\$4,288**, based upon 16 credit hours of instruction.

Likewise, continuing education registration fees continue to be based on the course length, consistent with the following schedule:

Course Length	Registration Fee
0-24 Hours	\$70
25-50 Hours	\$125
50+ Hours	\$180
