RE: 2020-21 Tuition and Registration Fee Rates

The memo is provided to notify colleges of 2020-21 tuition and registration fee rates.

G.S. 115D-5 states that “[t]he State Board shall have authority with respect to individual institutions... to establish and regulate student tuition and fees within policies for tuition and fees established by the General Assembly.” The General Assembly has NOT debated a tuition or registration fee increase during the current legislative session.

As the General Assembly has not enacted a tuition increase, curriculum tuition charged to students for the 2020-21 academic year shall remain at current levels:

Residents: The per credit hour charge shall remain **\$76.00**; up to a maximum per semester of **\$1,216**, based upon 16 credit hours of instruction.

Non-Residents: The per credit hour charge shall remain **\$268**; up to a maximum per semester of **\$4,288**, based upon 16 credit hours of instruction.

Likewise, continuing education registration fees continue to be based on the course length, consistent with the following schedule:

Course Length	Registration Fee
0-24 Hours	\$70
25-50 Hours	\$125
50+ Hours	\$180
