EME 3500	Emergency Dispatch	120	200	3

Rationale: The increase in hours will allow for additional course content to align with current industry standards.

Revised Description:

This course is designed to provide knowledge and skills necessary for working effectively within an Emergency 911 Telecommunications Center. Topics may include the role and responsibilities of public safety telecommunicators; basic call-taking techniques; technology and equipment in the Emergency Call Center; processing law enforcement, fire, and EMS calls for service; communication and documentation skills; dispatch prioritization, protocols, and quality assurance; tactical communication; managing high-risk and special-needs calls; liability, ethics and professional values; emotional intelligence; cultural awareness; critical thinking and problem-solving; stress management; first aid and CPR; FEMA Incident Command System; HazMat Awareness, Traffic Incident Management, and Geography/GIS. Course work will include instructor led lecture, hands on experience, and opportunities to participate in real time scenarios while learning essential multi-tasking techniques. Upon completion of this course, students will be prepared to effectively operate the functional aspects within an Emergency 911 Center.
