

The NCCCS-Glaxo SmithKline Teacher Promise Scholarship

The NCCCS-Glaxo SmithKline Teacher Promise program awards scholarships to students enrolled in the Associate in Arts in Teacher Preparation (A1010T) or Associate in Science in Teacher Preparation (A1040T) program.

Student Eligibility Requirements:

- Be enrolled in Associate in Arts in Teacher Preparation (A1010T) or Associate in Science in Teacher Preparation (A1040T) degree program.
- Completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for 2023-24 and have unmet need.
- Meet satisfactory academic progress standards as determined by the college.

College Requirements:

- May establish its own criteria and award students for the scholarship.
- May establish a scholarship committee to select the recipients of the scholarship.
- May be asked to provide a list of recipients for the scholarship to NCCCS.
- May be asked to return unexpended funds to NCCCS at the end of the fiscal year.
- Track student eligibility for two consecutive years, not including summer, if the student is enrolled full-time.
- Track student eligibility for four consecutive years, not including summer, if the student is enrolled at least half-time.

Other Criteria:

- Full-time students must be enrolled in at least 12 credit hours. Full-time students may receive the scholarship for up to two consecutive years, not including summer
- Part-time students must be enrolled at least half-time (6 credit hours). Part-time students will receive a reduced scholarship offer for up to four consecutive years, not including summer terms.
- The scholarship is not transferable.
