**SUBJECT:** Change of Deadline for Advanced EMT Programs

**DATE:** June 03, 2025

This memo provides information related to a change by the NC Office of Emergency Medical Services (NCOEMS) in the deadline for colleges to obtain accreditation for their Advanced EMT (AEMT) courses/programs.

NCOEMS has notified the System Office that they have delayed accreditation requirements for AEMT programs/courses from June 30, 2025, until June 30, 2026. This change also aligns with the deadline for the expenditure of High-Cost Health Care grants received by colleges to assist in the AEMT accreditation process.

- Approved Institutions wishing to offer <u>AEMT courses that begin on or after July 1, 2026</u>,
  will be required to provide one (1) of the following forms or documentation to the
  NCOEMS:
  - 1) CoAEMSP letter of Accreditation for AEMT;
  - 2) A CoAEMSP issued letter of review for AEMT;
  - 3) A paid receipt for AEMT Accreditation services.
